

Landfill hours – deferred until more data collected after summer season. To take place April 2022.

Proposed Police Services Board Structure – County committee with each municipality getting three seats. Trent Lakes Police Services Board will no longer exist.

Dewdney Mountain Farms Quarry Application – Resolution passed that council receive the reports from Gord Russell, G.H. Russell Planning and Development Services, regarding application for zoning By-Law Amendment (Dewdney Mountain Farms).

That Council receives the information and submissions requested through Council Resolution R2021-180. Many of the letters are on the agenda. If you are interested you can find all that information .

The application for zoning by-law amendment by Dewdney Mountain Farms Limited be declared complete. Staff is to provide notification to the public and to provide for review of the application and supporting studies and plans.

Council direct staff to coordinate the completion peer reviews of the new technical reports and plans submitted with the application prior to the scheduling of a public meeting.

The draft haul route agreement together with the alternate haul route be received for information in conjunction with the information in conjunction with the application for zoning by-law amendment and be referred to the Municipality's solicitor and peer review consultant.

Road Needs Study – An RFP will be issued for assessing road needs which hasn't been done since 2012.
