
Founded in 2001, KLT protects ecologically diverse lands

across the Kawarthas, some of which include hiking trails that introduce thousands of people to nature in the Kawarthas every year. Their success depends on the work of a dedicated and growing team of donors, volunteers and supporters.

KLT currently protects 34 properties covering 6,750 acres of important diverse types of land.
